Jury of Selections and Awards:

Jane Penfield - Jane Penfield is a signature member of the Pastel Society of America, The Connecticut Pastel Society, and an elected member of the American Artists Professional League. She teaches a weekly on line class in pastel and is a frequent workshop instructor and demo artist for many art groups. Her work evokes the constantly changing elements of the natural world as to the human influence on it. She is a past president of the Connecticut Pastel Society and of Arts Center east in Vernon, Connecticut. Other professional associations include New Haven Paint & Clay Club, Academic Artists Association, Pastel Painters Society of Cape Cod, Lyme Art Association, and others. The common thread throughout all of her work is the effect of light on the subject and how it expresses emotion, even in commonplace, everyday experiences.

Wendy Queiros - Since I've been a child, I have always had an eye for art. I craved it. My friends always remembered me with the Kodak camera especially with my dogs. Now, just about empty nesters, I needed something to keep me moving - especially in the winter. I sold my camera and bought a professional grade set up and off I went! My paintings are in private collections from Dubai to Singapore.
